IV MEETING ON INTERNATIONAL ECONOMICS

"Europe in Crisis: Recent Developments and Policy Implications"

**September 24-25, 2015,
Institute of International Economics (IEI),
University Jaume I, Spain**

The Institute of International Economics is pleased to announce the IV Meeting on International Economics. This fourth annual conference of the Institute of International Economics will bring together researcher interested in analyzing the economic crisis in Europe, its causes and consequences. Economic Modelling will publish a special issue with papers presented at the conference.

The conference will cover (but not limited to) the following issues:

1. How should a monetary union be designed to boost growth and competitiveness? Has the structure of the euro zone hampered economic convergence?
2. Can macroeconomic imbalances within a monetary union be overcome through adjustments in individual countries? Is real depreciation by southern countries the best policy response to the euro crisis?
3. What is the role of fiscal policy in stabilising regional shocks within a monetary union? Can fiscal consolidation cause greater inequality within countries and/or between countries?
4. Can the finance-led model of growth followed by the deficit countries in the euro zone explain the depth of the recession? What are the sources of the financial segmentation observed as a consequence of the crisis?
6. What role has the FDI played in preventing imbalances in the euro zone?
7. How has the economic crisis in Europe reshaped migration flows?

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE

Submissions of full papers should be in English and include title, keywords, JEL classification, full name(s) of author(s), affiliation, address, email, fax and phone of the (responsible) author. Several papers may be submitted.

A Special Issue of the leading generalist journal in Applied Economics "**Economic Modelling**" (Impact Factor: 0.736) will be published under the guest editorship of Òscar Jordà (University of California Davis and Federal Reserve Bank of San Francisco), Juan Ángel Lafuente (University Jaume I and Institute of International Economics), Javier Ordóñez (University Jaume I and Institute of International Economics) and Juan F. Rubio-Ramírez (Duke University and Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta).

The contents of the Special Issue will contain papers presented by authors who participated at the IV Meeting on International Economics. Regular journal standards apply.

Authors whose papers are accepted for presentation at the conference are encouraged to submit their papers for the Economic Modelling Special Issue.

Papers submitted for this Special Issue will undergo a **fast-track journal review** process and a **reduced 80 EUR submission fee will apply** (instead of the regular one that amounts to 120 EUR). This fee should be paid in addition to the conference fees at the time of registration.
